GENERAL EDUCATION CURRICULUM (42 credit hours)

The General Education Curriculum is required in all colleges and majors. This set of courses ensures broad learning across the humanities, arts, and social, biological, and physical sciences, while teaching competence in technology, communication, critical thinking, and analytical skills.

ENGLISH COMPOSITION (6 credit hours): ENGL 101 or ENGL 103 & 104, ENGL 102 or 115; ESOL 101 and 102

LITERATURE (3 cr hrs) Recommended courses: ENGL 201, 202, 203, 204, 205, 206, 210, 211, 212, 312, 319, 320, 332, 333, 334, 341, 342, 350, 370, 371, 373, 380, 381; FREN 302, 311, 322, 392; GERM 311; HUMN 151, 152, 200; SPAN 302, 320, 340

MATHEMATICS (6 cr hrs): Choose from any MATH or STAT with 3 cr hrs above MATH 109. Only one of Math 102, MTHS 102, MATH 105, MTHS 105, MATH 109, MTHS 109, or MATH 143 may be used for degree credit. MATH 102 and MTHS 102 are not applicable to PSYC Majors. Recommended courses: MATH 105, 109; and MATH 110, 143, 206, 210, 250, 270, 301; MTHS 102 & 102S, 105 & 105S, 109 & 109S; STAT 214

HISTORY (3 cr hrs): Choose from any course in HIST (except HIST 490) or PHIL (except PHIL 316). Recommended courses: 100, 101, 102, 221, 222, 307, 321, 322, 330, 343, 351, 352, 355; PHIL 101, 321, 322

SOCIAL/BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE (6 cr hrs) 3 credit hours must be at the 200-level or above. Choose from any of the following courses in ANTH, CJUS, ECON, GEOG, POLS, PSYC, SOCI. Recommended courses: ANTH 100, 201, 202, 203; CJUS 101, 203, 205; ECON 201, 202, 300; GEOG 103, 104, 380; POLS 110, 220, 360, 370; PSYC, 110, 220, 255, 311, 312, 370; SOCI 100, 241. Required courses cannot be the same as the student's major.

NATURAL SCIENCES (9 cr hrs) Psychology major requires students to take two **BIOLOGY** courses and one **Physical Science** course. Science requirements **MAY NOT** be satisfied by three courses in the same subject or natural science area. Only **ONE** course of BIOL 110, 121, or 201 can be used towards a degree. Courses from major sequence cannot be mixed-matched with courses from non-major sequence. Only **ONE** course of GEOL 105, 111, 115 or 225 can be used towards a degree. Recommend courses: BIOL 110, 112, 111, 121, 122, 300, 303; CHEM 101, 102, ENVS 100 (physical sci.), 280 (physical sci.); GEOL 105, 106, 110; PHYS 160, 170, 213.

COMMUNICATION (3 cr hrs) Choose from any CMCN or MODL course. Recommended courses: CMCN 100, 202, 212, 302, 310, 345; ENGL 223, 355, 356, 357, 358, 359, 360, 365; THEA 261; ARAB 101, 102; ASL 101, 102, 201; FREN 101, 102, 201, 202, 216, 301, 316, 332, 361, 362; GERM 101, 102, 201, 202, 216, 360; SPAN 101, 102, 201, 202, 216, 301, 310, 316, 330, 332

University Graduation Requirements

- In order to qualify for a baccalaureate degree, a student must complete all courses prescribed by the degree program they have elected, or their equivalent, as indicated in the Catalog in effect at the time they entered the degree program. Any variation, including substitutions and/or waiver of courses, must be approved in writing by the student's academic dean. If a student changes their elected degree program, they are required to follow the degree program as printed in the Catalog in effect at the time of the change. With approval of their academic dean a student may be allowed to elect to work under the current Catalog.
- The minimum total of semester credit hours required for a baccalaureate degree is 120. Certain degree programs may require more than 120 credit hours.
- Of the total credit hours required for the degree, a minimum of 45 credit hours of 300/400-level courses are required.
- The University requires that all students complete a specified set of 42 credit hours of general education courses ("core curriculum") over the course of their baccalaureate degree program.
- A maximum of 60 credit hours transferred from community colleges may be applied to the degree program. Remedial or developmental courses will not count towards the degree and are not included in the 60 credit hours transferred.
- The absolute minimum requirements for graduation are an adjusted grade point average of at least 2.0. *Students must attain at least a 2.0 minimum adjusted grade point average to graduate.*
- A student, in order to be eligible for the baccalaureate degree, shall be required to earn at least 30 credit hours or 25% of the total credit hours, applicable toward the degree, in residence at the University.

COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS REQUIREMENTS

- All Liberal Arts majors are required to complete a minor, which is a chosen secondary area of study comprised of a minimum of 18 credit hours. - Continuing UL Lafayette students who plan to take courses at another institution as part of their degree plan must seek formal approval for each course from their Academic Dean prior to enrollment. *A special waiver of residency is required during the students' last 30 credit hours.*
- Students may apply no more than 42 credit hours above the 100-level of major courses toward a degree. Approved exceptions include Communication and English majors/concentrations at 45 credit hours above the 100-level.
- Transfer courses are currently evaluated at the departmental level in collaboration with the Office of the Registrar. Once evaluated, all coursework is posted on the student's unofficial UL transcript that can be found in the Student Profile. Contact the Dean's Office for clarification on any transfer work.

GRADUATION APPLICATION

- **The Graduation Check Sheet:** Indicates what course work remains to complete degree requirements. Students must complete the Check Sheet with their academic advisor during their **second-to-last semester**; the academic advisors must submit the students' Check Sheet to the Dean's Office before the end of the **second-to-last semester**. *Delays in submitting a timely Check Sheet may also delay a student's graduation.*
- **The Application for Degree:** Required to ensure students receive their diploma during graduation and is to be completed well prior to graduation, according to posted deadlines. Submitting the Application for Degree prior to the final semester ensures priority registration for graduating seniors. The application is available through the student's ULink account and payments can also be made through your Statement of Account on ULink.
